Highlights from 2007

The Association addressed a number of maintenance items last year. These included complete replacement of the southern ocean access walkway, maintenance on the northern and center ocean access walkways, fixing the erosion problem on the sound access path, clearing additional brush on the edge of the sound access path and at the edge of the sound, fixing water and electrical problems at the south sign, replaced the lighting on the south sign and provided some holiday decorations on the south sign. The Association also reviewed/expanded the Association insurance policies, monitored events and activities around the Town of Duck and posted information and maintenance pictures on the Association website.

Also in 2007, the Association website was created and hosted, a new/enhanced membership database was created and welcome letters (containing Association information) were sent to new owners in Carolina Dunes.

The cost associated with all of the maintenance work that was required was high last year, so we would greatly appreciate your timely payment of the annual Association fee. This fee is the primary source of funds. Without it, the maintenance and web services described above could not be provided. We kindly ask that all owners stay current with their fees.

Your 2008 Association Fees Are Due

The annual Association fee, still only \$75, is the primary source of funds for all activities. This fee covers maintenance of the 3 ocean access ramps/steps, maintenance of the sound access path, maintenance of the 2 Carolina Dunes signs and surrounding landscaping on NC 12, website, communications, letters, postage, special projects and all other Association expenses. The annual fee is a small amount for each homeowner to

pay, and we ask that each homeowner kindly send payment to help support the Association, which is only community organization that uniquely serves all homeowners in Carolina Dunes.

If you received this newsletter as an attachment to an email, the message in email will let you know if your Association fees are due. If you received this newsletter through the US Post Office, check your mailing label on the cover page. Above your name, on the right, is the date of your last dues payment (YYYY/MM format). If this date is highlighted in yellow, your 2008 fee (\$75) is due and should be sent to Carolina Dunes Association, Inc, Box 8153, Duck, NC 27949. Write your check to Carolina Dunes Association, Inc. Please note your Carolina Dunes address on the check. Thank you!

Proposed By-Law Changes

There will be a discussion and vote on proposed by-law changes at the annual meeting in March. A summary of the main changes are listed below:

<u>Document Cleanup.</u> Edited text to:

- Correct spelling errors
- Be consistent with use of upper/lower case letters
- Improve readability and understandability of sentences
- Use language specific to Carolina Dunes

Article I. Eliminated out-of-date address and made addresses generic so that the bylaws don't have to be changed each time new officers are elected.

Article III, Section 3. Changed annual dues period-of-time to Jan 1st through Dec 31st (from the 1st of Mar through the end of the following Feb) to avoid membership confusion over whether dues have been paid. Also set a deadline date of the end of Feb for the dues to be paid.

<u>Article IV, Section 1</u>. Changed member notification period to match the period listed in Section 3 to improve consistency.

Article IV, Section 4. Changed quorum from 10% to 5% to ensure annual meetings can be conducted. A quorum of 10% would require 22 properties to be represented. It's

common that roughly 30 people attend the annual meetings, but that usually includes husbands and wives. It's likely that fewer than 22 properties have sometimes been represented at past annual meetings.

Article VI, Section 1. Changed the minimal size of the Board from 7 to 5 to make it easier to find candidates for Board members and to make it easier for the entire Board to be actively engaged in Association activities.

<u>Article VI, Section 11</u>. Add a provision that provides for special rules, procedures and potential fees for non-owners who may want to use Carolina Dunes access paths.

A copy of the current and proposed by-laws are posted on the 'History' page of the Association website (www.CarolinaDunes.org).

If you have any questions or concerns over the changes, we ask that you communicate them to Ron Blunck or any other Officer or Board member before the annual meeting, especially if you can't attend the meeting.

Ron maintains the Association membership database, and he can mark your file so we will use your mailing address.

If we have an email address for you, we will assume you can receive information via the internet and will not send postal mail to you unless we hear from you.

Automatic Notification For Association Website Updates

Since the Association will be using the website to communicate information, you may want to receive automatic notification whenever there is a change posted to the website. Getting posted when changes are made would eliminate the need to periodically scrolling through the website looking for new information.

All internet users can subscribe to RSS (Real Simple Syndication) to automatically receive notification of changes. There are several types of notification from which to select. An explanation of RSS and a description of the process to subscribe to RSS can be found on the Association website. RSS services are free.

To get started with RSS, click on the small orange icon below the blue 'Contact Us' link on the home page.

Trash & Recyclable Collections

Trash collection days during the summer season (Memorial Day through Labor Day) in Carolina Dunes will continue to be Monday and Friday. Please make sure to put the containers out the night before and bring them back under your house after collection. It's particularly important for renters to use the Friday collection to avoid excessive amounts of trash over the weekend. It's a good idea to put trash collection information on your refrigerator door, especially for renters

Recyclables should be placed in the blue containers and put out on Fridays.

Fire Safety

To help prevent fires, it would be advisable to keep grass around BBQ units cut short and to encourage the use of propane BBQs instead of charcoal BBQs. Any dried grass around BBQs should be removed.

If you rent your house, you may want to post some fire safety points on your refrigerator for your renters to read.

For owners and renters alike, you should quickly call 911 should you see any fire that is not under total control.

Bulk Waste Pick Up on Friday, March 28

The date for Duck's semi-annual bulk waste collection has been set for Friday, March 28, 2008. On that day, no later than 5:00 a.m.,

please leave bulk waste out by the curb for collection by employees of Waste Management. Bulk waste can include all large items that you want to dispose of except the following: refrigerators or appliances that contain hazardous waste (refrigerant/Freon); hazardous materials such as paints, solvents, chemicals, etc.; and building materials or demolition debris, roofing, soil, rocks, concrete and stumps. These materials will not be collected. Yard and vegetative debris will be collected; however they must be bagged or tied in bundles of four foot lengths or less with each bundle weighing no more than 50 pounds, otherwise it will not be picked up.
